## Mazda Bongo Equipment List

Our Mazda Bongo comes equipped as follows – anything else you think you will need you should bring with you:

- 1 x electric hookup cable.
- 1 x gas bottle.
- 1 x clean water container.
- 1 x waste water container.
- 1 x washing up bowl.
- 1 x Frying pan.
- 1 x Saucepan.
- 1 x Small kettle for use on the gas stove (if you have electric hookup you may prefer to bring an electric kettle as this is quicker and easier than using the hob).
- 4 x large plates.
- 4 x small plates.
- 4 x bowls.
- 4 x mugs.
- 4 x polycarbonate wine glasses.
- 4 x polycarbonate pint glasses.
- 4 x polycarbonate half pint glasses.
- 4 x knives.
- 4 x forks.
- 4 x spoons.
- 4 x tea spoons.
- 1 x sharp knife.
- 1 x scissors.
- 1 x spatula.
- 1 x bottle opener.
- 1 x chopping board (please do not chop directly on the Bongo work surfaces as they scratch easily).
- 1 x low power ac inverter (powers phone chargers and laptops max 150w from the battery).

Hirers may wish to bring (these are suggestions only and the list is non-exhaustive):

- Sheets the use of sheets or sleeping bags is mandatory for hygiene reasons and to prevent staining of the mattresses. Sheets are not included in your hire.
- Sleeping bags.
- Pillows.
- Blankets/duvet in winter/spring/autumn.
- Clothes.
- Towels.
- Toiletries.
- Hairdryer (if using electric hookup only the inverter will not power a hairdryer).
- Hair straighteners (if using electric hookup only the inverter will not power a hairdryer).
- Outdoor chairs.
- Bottle opener.
- Food.
- Drinks.
- Washing up liquid.
- Tea towels.
- Kitchen towel.
- Toilet roll (even if staying on a campsite, having your own can be a good idea!)
- Mobile phone and charger.

• Sat Nav or map.

## Fuel (petrol/diesel)

There will be enough fuel in the Bongo to at least get you to the nearest petrol station. Please return the Bongo with the same amount of fuel as when you collected it. The fuel level will be marked on your hire agreement.
