Motorhome Equipment List



Packing

Our motorhomes comes equipped as follows – anything else you think you will need you should bring with you:

- 1 x electric hookup cable (25m).
- 1 x refillable gas bottle please return full. Alternatively we offer a full to empty option for £20.
- 1 x Frying pan.
- 2 x Saucepan.
- 1 x Small kettle for use on the gas stove
- 1 x low power ac inverter (powers phone chargers and laptops max 150w from the battery).
- 1 x set silver screens.
- 2 x levelling chocks.
- 1 x 5m water hose.
- Crockery Box available on request (free of charge) containing:
 - 6 x large plates.
 - 6 x small plates.
 - 6 x bowls.
 - 6 x mugs.
 - 6 x wine glasses.
 - 6 x small glasses.
 - 6 x knives.
 - 6 x forks.
 - 6 x spoons.
 - 6 x tea spoons.
 - 1 x sharp knife.
 - 1 x scissors.
 - 1 x spatula.
 - 1 x bottle opener/corkscrew.
 - 1 x can opener.
 - 1 x chopping board (please do not chop directly on the motorhome work surfaces or hob glass as they scratch easily).

Hirers must bring:

- Sheets the use of sheets is mandatory for hygiene reasons and to prevent staining of the mattresses. Sheets are not included in your hire.
- Cleaning materials (no bleach bleach will damage the plastics in the bathroom!)
- Towels.
- Matches/lighter (for models without electric ignition on the hob).

Hirers may wish to bring (these are suggestions only and the list is non-exhaustive):

- Sleeping bags/duvet.
- Pillows.
- Blankets in winter/spring/autumn.
- Clothes.

- Toiletries.
- Hairdryer (if using electric hookup only the inverter will not power a hairdryer).
- Hair straighteners (if using electric hookup only the inverter will not power hair straighteners).
- Outdoor table and chairs (table and chairs are available to hire on request).
- Food.
- Toaster (if staying on campsite with electric hookup).
- Drinks.
- Washing up liquid.
- Tea towels.
- Kitchen towel.
- Toilet roll (even if staying on a campsite, having your own can be a good idea!)
- Mobile phone and charger.
- Sat Nav or map.
- TV (mains powered if you're on hookup, otherwise 12v and coaxial cable to plug into the motorhome aerial).
- Torch.

Water, gas & fuel (petrol/diesel)

Fuel (petrol/diesel)

There will be enough fuel in the motorhome to at least get you to the nearest fuel station. Please return the motorhome with the same amount of fuel as when you collected it. The fuel level will be marked on your hire agreement.

<u>Gas</u>

The motorhome will come with either a refillable lpg gas bottle. This can be refilled at LPG petrol stations, enabling topping up and removing the need for a second bottle.

Water

It is recommended that you travel with both waste water and clean water tanks empty and fill them up at your destination. Campsites have water filling points as do most festivals and events that provide camping facilities.

Travelling with the water empty reduces fuel consumption (both tanks when full weigh nearly a quarter of a tonne!) and improves handling and breaking distances.

The water tanks on your motorhome will therefore be empty when you collect your motorhome.

Parking

You're welcome to leave 1 car per motorhome at our yard (free of charge) for the duration of your hire. We will ask you to leave your keys with us while you're away in case we need to move your car or the alarm goes off (our yard is adjacent to a residential property!).
